HIGH SCHOOL REORGANIZATION
PROPOSED TIMELINE

Introductory comments: This timeline is our recommended time sequence for the complete reorganization of our high schools. This is not, by any means, an exhaustive list of the very many details that would need to be worked out and decisions that need to be made in order to make this project successful and fully supported by our parents, students, and residents. It is meant to be an outline of the timeline that the administration recommends to move the project forward. Again, there are numerous details and tough decisions that will need to be made but we believe this timeline would give us the necessary time and structure to make this happen.

- November 2012 Referendum to fund high school renovations and expansion passes
- Voters show support for initiative by voting for funding expenditure (referendum)
 - Architect is hired and plans are developed for new high school
- September 2013 Year 1 of high school consolidation begins*
- All of the ninth graders from JFK transition to Fermi
 - Fermi remains a 9 – 12 building
 - Enfield High becomes a 10 – 12 building for one year
 - Freshman sports are reinstated
 - Staff from EHS are assigned to Fermi to accommodate the increase in ninth grade enrollment
 - Instructional materials and texts are transferred to Fermi
- September 2014 Year 2 of high school consolidation continues
- Again, all of the ninth graders from JFK transition to Fermi
 - Fermi remains a 9 – 12 building but now has all of the ninth and tenth graders in the district in the building.
 - Enfield High becomes a 11 – 12 building
 - This year our high school will open under one name as determined by the Board of Education. It will be a “One School – Two Campus” arrangement.
 - Athletic teams will combine at this time.
 - School administrations combine at this time. Principal will be named.
 - Staff from EHS are assigned to Fermi to accommodate the increase in ninth and tenth grade enrollment.
 - Instructional materials and texts are transferred to Fermi.
 - Depending on building utilization some renovations could begin. Complete renovations can begin in June 2015.

September 2015

Year 3 of high school consolidation continues

- Enfield High closes doors for construction and renovations
- Fermi remains open for grades 10 – 12 however opens under name of combined high school.
- Ninth graders from JFK will move into transitional building (perhaps Stowe) for a one year temporary situation.
- Current administration will be responsible for both buildings.
- Staff will be reallocated to accommodate this arrangement.
- EHS will be emptied out and contents will be stored, used at Fermi, sold, or disposed of.

September 2016

Consolidation completed. New high school opens doors for all Enfield students in grades 9 – 12.

*If referendum fails Year 1 activities do not occur.
