## SUPERINTENDENT'S RECOMMENDATIONS on SCHOOL REORGANIZATION & TIME LINES

## **Objectives:**

Reorganize into a PK-2 grades and 3-5 grades elementary utilizing seven buildings;

Reorganize into a 6-8 grades middle school utilizing the current JFK building;

Reorganize into a 9-12 grades high school utilizing the Fermi High building.

Time Lines:

Phase I for September 2010 -

Close Alcorn School and distribute Alcorn students in grades K-5 to Parkman, Stowe, & Whitney School.

Move approximately 10 sections of 6<sup>th</sup> graders from Alcorn, Parkman, Stowe, Whitney, and Enfield Street to JFK Middle School.

Phase II for September 2011 -

Determine via feasibility study to close Stowe or Hale School (11/1/10);

By 12/14/10 BOE meeting complete plans to:

Make Barnard & Hazardville Memorial K-2 buildings;
Make Whitney PK-2 grades building;
Make either Stowe or Hale a K-2 building per 11/1/10 selection.
Make Crandall, Enfield Street, & Parkman 3-5 buildings;
Move all remaining 6th graders to JFK Middle School.

By February 1, 2011 students know assignments for opening of school.

Phase III determined by construction completion -

Consolidate all 9-12 graders into Fermi building.

May 13, 2010
